- Overseeing the management of PSP's finances, legal exposure and obligations
- Actively participating in board meetings by reviewing agendas and supporting materials in advance of the meetings
- Actively serving on committees or task forces and taking on relevant special projects
- Staying informed about the activities of PSP and employment trends both generally and in the field of collegiate-based fraternal organizations
- Championing PSP and its mission by representing PSP to stakeholders and functioning as a goodwill ambassador for PSP and its services
- Maintaining confidentiality
- Being an annual donor to the Foundation as a Leadership Circle member each fiscal year during the time of service
