

NOW ACCEPTING NOMINATIONS FOR THE 2020-22 NATIONAL NOMINATING COMMITTEE

Dear Alpha Chi Omega Sisters,

The National Council is seeking members to serve on Alpha Chi Omega's 2020-22 National Nominating Committee (NNC). The NNC is charged with identifying women who have the vision, skills and professional experience to serve as the elected board leadership of Alpha Chi Omega on the 2022-24 National Council.

In accordance with Fraternity policies, the National Council will prepare a slate of candidates for the NNC to be voted on by delegates at the 2020 National Convention in Baltimore, Maryland. The slate will consist of five alumnae members (one of whom is slated as the chair-elect) and one alternate alumna member. In addition to these alumnae members, there shall be one collegiate member and one alternate collegiate member of the NNC who will be selected by the alumnae members of the NNC during the first year of their term.

In preparing the slate, the National Council attempts to assemble a team of women who are representative of our membership and knowledgeable of important issues of the Fraternity as well as its governance structure.

The work of the 2020-22 NNC begins after the 2020 National Convention and culminates in summer 2022 when the NNC presents a slate of candidates (one National President and five national vice presidents) to the 2022 National Convention delegates for election.

Qualifications

Nominees should be Alpha Chi Omega alumnae in good standing with an understanding of board governance and the National Fraternity and with the ability to analyze the needs of the Fraternity and qualifications of prospective candidates.

Experience recruiting board members for nonprofit organizations and/or prior participation in a confidential nomination and slating process is experience that can advance the Fraternity.

NNC members agree to maintain strict confidentiality regarding prospective nominees and the deliberations of the committee and shall have no conflicts of interest with the National Fraternity, including potential for personal financial gain from National Council decisions.

Candidates for the NNC may not, at the time of slating and election or at any point during the NNC term to which they were elected, serve on any Alpha Chi Omega corporation board or hold any office which makes them a voting delegate at the 2020 or 2022 National Convention, including being a Past National President. Members of the 2020-22 NNC agree not to be candidates for the 2022-24 National Council.

What is the term of office?

Alumnae members: two years (August 1, 2020 – July 31, 2022)

Chair-elect: four years (August 1, 2020 – July 31, 2024)

Accountability / Working Relationship

The NNC is responsible to the Fraternity membership via the national convention delegates. The staff liaison to the NNC is the chief executive officer.
