- Be a Life Loyal member.

Committee Timeline

The domestic violence awareness fundraising committee meets bi-monthly via conference call at a date and time agreed upon by the committee lead specialist and committee members. Committee members will have the opportunity to renew their volunteer role at the end of the calendar year. Lead specialists can serve in a lead role for two consecutive years.
