



Volunteer Position: Ritual & Fraternity Appreciation (RFA) Specialist

Position Summary:

Assist collegiate chapters with activities associated with Alpha Chi Omega's Ritual and fraternity appreciation in general. Each collegiate RFA specialist is assigned to a province, and typically works with one to three chapters and on one project.

Essential Functions:

1. Work directly with collegiate chapters to assess the Ritual and Fraternity Appreciation committee and evaluate how the chapter uses our Ritual.
2. Be knowledgeable of existing resources and how each may be utilized by chapters
3. Engage in team projects, including the development of Ritual and VP RFA resources for chapters' use.

Qualifications:

Volunteers should be alumnae in good standing with the organization; able to commit one to three hours each week as based on the chapters' needs; and have the capacity to work remotely/virtually with other team members and chapters.
