

Communication Guide if a Member Tests Positive During Recruitment

This resource includes steps that will need to be taken if a member tests positive during recruitment. This should be reviewed with all chapter members during pre-recruitment and primary recruitment.

WHAT IF SOMEONE IN MY BUMP GROUP TESTS POSITIVE?

- The positive member should notify the chapter president (CP), VP recruitment (VP R) and VP recruitment information (VP RI) immediately.
 - The member should also notify her close contacts (which could include members outside of her bump group, roommates, etc.).
- The CP and VP RI should notify the member's bump group.
 - Vaccinated members of the group should continue wearing masks, monitor symptoms and test within 3-5 days of exposure.
 - Unvaccinated members of the group should begin to quarantine for 10 days and will no longer be able to participate in recruitment or Bid Day, unless the 10 days have passed before Bid Day occurs.
 - The VP RI will need to work to re-match the PNMs that the member was assigned to meet for the remainder of that round.
- Depending on the number of members in the bump group who will then be out for the remainder of recruitment, the VP RI will determine how the bump group is managed going forward.
 - If there are not enough members left to make up the bump group, those remaining members can be substituted into another bump group that is not full.
- During a break for meals or at the end of the day, the CP should provide full chapter updates if a member has tested positive that day.
 - Utilize the Chapter Communication Template for email communication.
- Member confidentiality should continue to be maintained.

IF SOMEONE MUST ISOLATE AFTER TESTING POSITIVE, HOW WILL WE REDISTRIBUTE BUMP GROUPS AND RE-MATCH PNM'S?

- If remaining members of the bump group are vaccinated and are not showing symptoms, then they can be placed in other bump groups.
- PNM's in remaining parties for that round who were paired/matched to a member who tested positive or needs to quarantine/isolate can be re-distributed to any ghost recruiters or bump groups who were not already signed PNM's for that specific party.
- The VP recruitment information can also have members pick up two PNM's at the door and "double recruit," as a last resort if needed.
