

Foundation Board of Trustees

The Alpha Chi Omega Foundation serves to support the educational and philanthropic purposes of Alpha Chi Omega through effective fundraising and stewardship of financial resources. The Foundation Board of Trustees is given the corporate authority and responsibility to strive to best achieve the Foundation's mission.

The Board of Trustees is comprised of a total of seven alumnae trustees and three National Council trustees. All trustees serve with a primary governing focus of providing the strategic vision for the Foundation to achieve its mission. Their secondary and operational focus is on fundraising in conjunction with the Foundation professional staff team. Alumnae trustees serve a three-year term.

Trustee responsibilities include:

- Understanding, supporting and consistently promoting the mission of the Alpha Chi Omega Foundation
- Enhancing the Alpha Chi Omega Foundation's public image
- Approving and assisting in the development and oversight of the current Enterprise Strategic Plan
- Exercising fiduciary responsibility in the investment of, accounting for and acknowledgement of all contributions as well as expenses
- Identifying prospective donors, trustees and volunteers for the Foundation
- Cultivating and soliciting donor prospects as assigned by the chief development officer
- Participating in Foundation-sponsored fundraising events
- Maintaining strict confidentiality with donor information
- Making an unrestricted donation of a minimum of \$1,000 to the Foundation for each fiscal year for the term of service and providing financial support for any campaigns

Individuals Interested in serving as an alumna trustee should submit their résumé and letter of interest to Billi Carson, director of executive operations, at bcarson@alphachiomega.org or mail it to headquarters. Candidates are screened for their experience and expertise in the areas of fundraising, legal, finance and board governance, as well as matched to the current needs of the board. Diversity and inclusiveness are also key priorities. Nominations are reviewed and phone interviews are conducted by the Foundation Nominating Chair Carmen Rene and other trustees.

All nominations are due March 1, 2019.
